The 2022 festival season feels like a joyous welcome home party after so long. Masks on or off, audiences and artists are lining up for live and in-person musical and terpsichorean performances in picturesque settings around the world, in vineyards, mountains, valleys, lakeshores, and amphitheaters historic and modern.

What is especially striking about the 115 festivals in this year's Guide (our largest to date) is how many of them are celebrating their anniversaries. Promising "an anniversary edition not to be missed," France's Besançon Music Festival will honor its 75th season with 30 concerts

Besançon and environs in Also coming up on 75 years is the ever-youthful Ojai Music Festival in Northern California, with this year's music director, the American Modern Opera Company (AMOC), promising a long weekend of avantgarde surprises, as is the Ojai tradition.

Heading into its centenary is the Handel Festival in Halle, Germany, with an adaptation of its 1922 programming, starting with the full staging of *Orlando* at the Halle Opera House. Another early music specialist, the Shenandoah Valley Bach Festival in Harrison Valley, VA, plans a 40th-anniversary performance of the complete B-minor Mass and, in a nod to one very un-Bach composer, Florence Price's *Mississippi River Suite*. In other round-number celebrations, the Santa Fe (NM) Desert Chorale has dubbed its season "Caminante: Journey through 40 Years," while who better than the chamber virtuosi at Music@Menlo in Atherton, CA, to examine "Haydn Connections" through the years.

As usual, we've packed the Guide with the essentials, including dates, geographic and venue information, ticket prices and purchase links, pandemic safety links as needed, artistic directors, performers, web addresses, and social media links galore. Personally, I've already got one foot out the door, heading to the mountains, valleys, and any place in between for some serious music-making and listening. Hope you are too.


