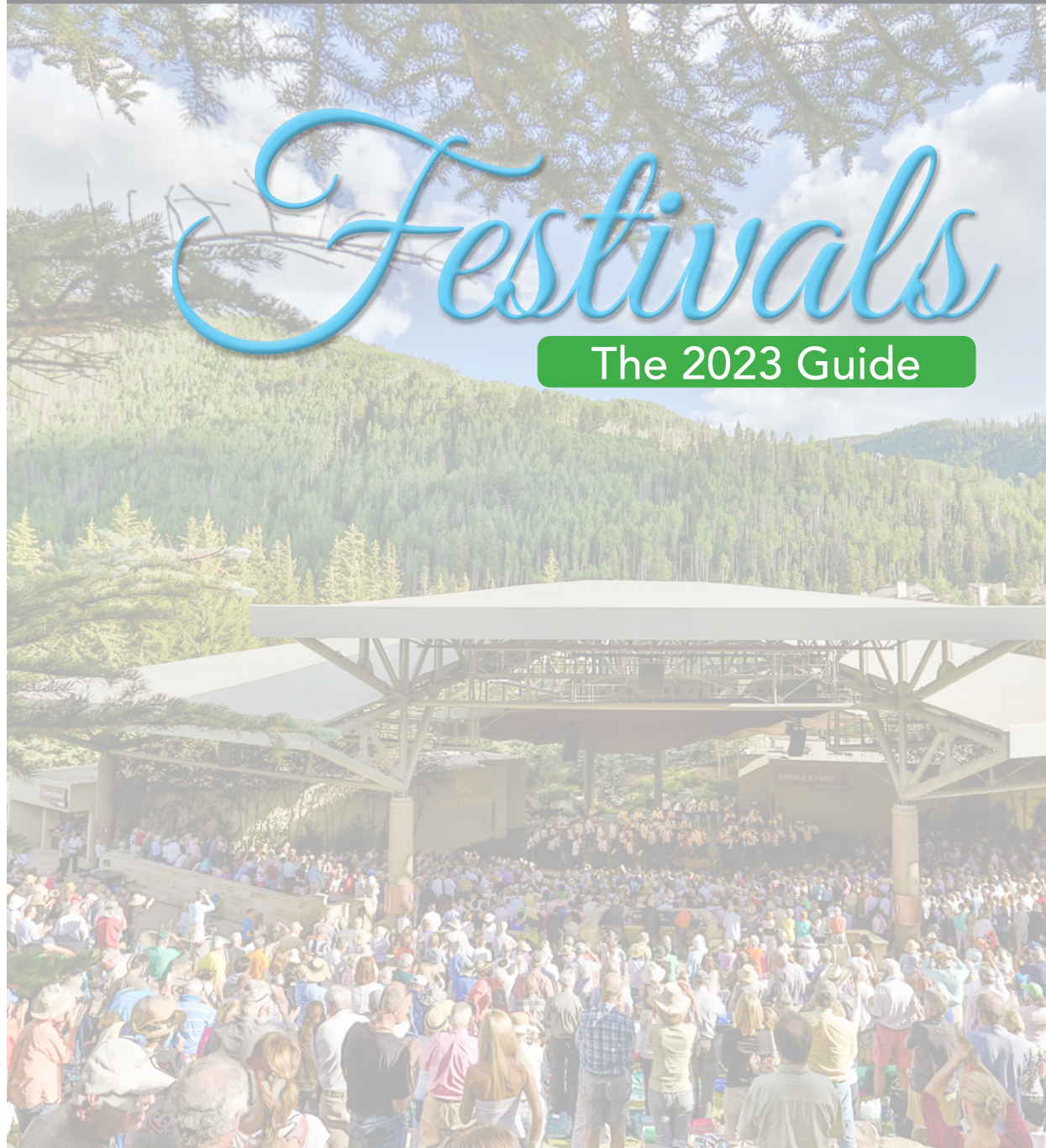

The 2023 Guide





## Editor's Note



Looking over our largest-ever Guide, I am struck by the breadth of offerings, not only of repertoire, but also of vintage, genre, and practitioner—from rising artist to devoted amateur to seasoned pro and all points in between. Some festivals are also training academies, the best-known including Aspen, Tanglewood, Lucerne, and Verbier. Others are strictly geared to serve a paying public, such as Philadelphia's Mann Center or the Bravo! Vail Music Festival.

Many are both, with lessons, workshops, rehearsals by day and public concerts by night. Marlboro Music Festival is one of those; so are the Glimmerglass Festival and Santa Fe Opera, whose apprentices are apt to appear in the minor roles of its mainstage productions. One of Santa Fe's curiosities this summer is a new orchestration of the oldest surviving opera in the repertoire, Monteverdi's *Orfeo*, dating to 1607, by relative newcomer to the canon (and polar opposite stylistically) Nico Muhly, b. 1981. Even the concept sounds wild.

In summertime, much of a festival's charm can be tied to its locale: The gardens of William Christie in France will host Les Arts Florissants in music of the baroque; California's lush Festival Napa Valley offers chamber music as well as the premiere of Gordon Getty's new opera, *Annie Laurie* (with a cool Chardonnay on tap at intermission); the tree-draped Libbey Bowl at Ojai will host Rhiannon Giddens's reportorial choices, advertised as "Baroque to Black"; the sprawling lawn at Tanglewood (or, for a higher price, the Koussevitzky Shed) is the site of full-blown Brahms by the Boston Symphony under Andris Nelsons. For city dwellers with a taste for mostly 21st-century music by some of its best-known practitioners, such as the Talea Ensemble, JACK Quartet, or the International Contemporary Ensemble, the TIME:SPANS Festival at New York's DiMenna Center for Classical Music offers two weeks of works by new and rising musical minds. And for amateurs who love to sing, Berkshire Choral International has a week in Florence, with Heinz Ferlesch conducting the Verdi Requiem at Teatro Verdi. Time to start warming up the 'cords.
