Editor's Note



We have reached a record—this year's Festivals Guide is the largest ever, with about 120 national and international listings of everything from intimate chamber music concerts in the 430-seat Luigi Rasi Theater in Ravenna, Italy, to full Bruckner-size symphonic blowouts by the Los Angeles Philharmonic in the Hollywood Bowl, capacity 17,500.

Some festivals come equipped with their own in-house orchestra: If the Bowl has the LA Phil (not to be confused with the freelance Hollywood Bowl Orchestra), Tanglewood has the Boston Symphony Orchestra. The Ravinia Festival lays claim to the Chicago Symphony, along with an array of pop acts; similarly, the Blossom Music Festival has the Cleveland Orchestra for a number of concerts. Saratoga Performing Arts Center is summer home to the Philadelphia Orchestra (along with the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center and the New York City Ballet), which also performs at the Mann Center AND Bravo! Vail, where it is joined (on alternate dates) by the Dallas Symphony and the New York Philharmonic.

Other festivals create their own performance groups, either comprised of freelance professionals, students, or a combination of both. Such is the Aspen Music Festival's tradition, as well as the Spoleto USA and Cabrillo Music festivals'. The Grand Teton Festival Orchestra is comprised of pros from some 50 major orchestras, from Minnesota to Atlanta to Boston. San Diego's Mainly Mozart All-Star Orchestra Festival comes together much the same way. Tanglewood has a student orchestra as well as the BSO, the Ojai Festival has a different one every summer—this year it's the Mahler Chamber Orchestra with its leader, Mitsuko Uchida.

Come festival season, the Cincinnati Symphony becomes the pit band for the Cincinnati Opera and the May Festival, just as the Saint Louis Symphony does for Opera Theater of Saint Louis. The Gershwins and their librettist (the oft-uncredited DuBose Heyward) may have posited that the "livin' is easy" in summertime, but the worker-bee musicians behind these 120 festivals would surely argue otherwise.

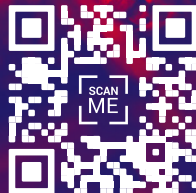

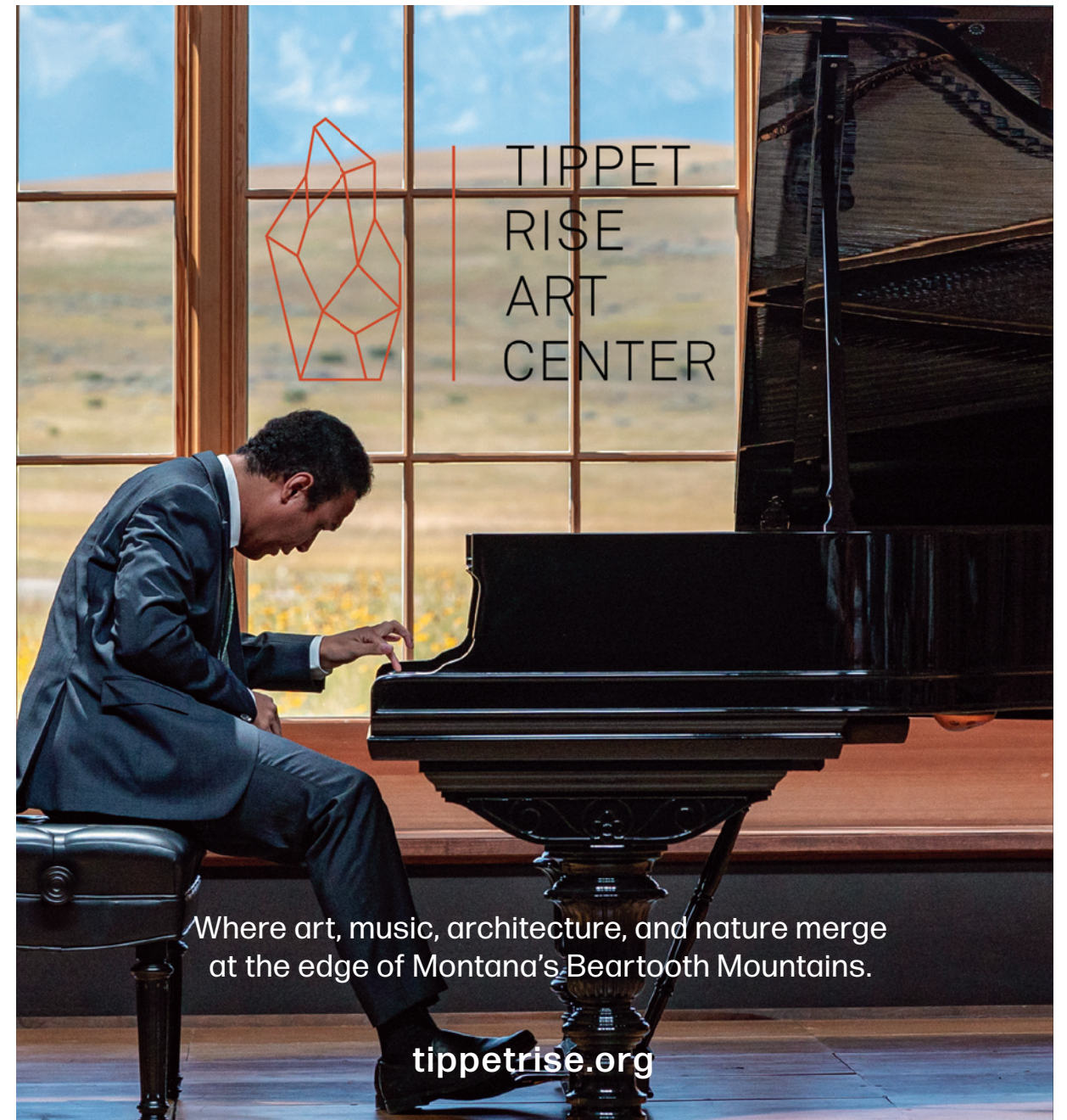
