# **Editor's Note**



Browsing through our 2026 Guide to Music Schools, I am struck by the number of specialty course offerings among our entrants. Getting a BA or BM these days seems like just the first step on a complex path to developing an expertise applicable to the contemporary job market in the arts.

For instance, Carnegie Mellon University touts its "BXA" Intercollege Degree Program, which enables students to earn

a degree in music and complement it with other, perhaps more real-world, skills. Both the BSA (Bachelor of Science and Arts) and the MSA tap into three different CMU Schools: Music, Computer Science, and Electrical Computer Engineering. BESA (Bachelor of Engineering Studies and Arts) involves both the College of Fine Arts and the College of Engineering, and the BCSA (Bachelor of Computer Science and Arts) crosses computer science with music, apparently without engineering.

The Peabody Institute at Johns Hopkins University also offers a number of double degrees, so students can pursue—usually over a five-year period—a BM or BFA track simultaneously with a BS degree from either the Krieger School of Arts and Sciences or the Whiting School of Engineering. Granted, they'll have to take a shuttle bus between two different Johns Hopkins campuses to do so (they're about 8 blocks apart), but the pursuit of interdisciplinary expertise is worth the time and effort. (Shuttles between the campuses run every 15 minutes.)


Bard College, considerably smaller than either of the above, actually requires students to follow a double degree track, also over a five-year stretch. Music students earn both a BM and a BA degree in a field other than music. The idea is that expertise in music will have its strongest impact if applied from a broader context of knowledge. Recent enrollment has seen students majoring in viola and Italian, trombone and sociology, composition and mathematics, and violin and psychology. This last seems like the ideal skill set, equally applicable to the practitioner and their audience.
